BE IT RESOLVED that National Department of Education works closely and collaboratively with the Kosrae State Department of Education to plan, execute and report on the 2nd Annual Micronesia Teachers Education Conference; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be transmitted to the President, Federated States of Micronesia, Speaker of the 16th FSM Congress, Governors of the FSM States and Chairpersons of the State Boards of Education.







A Resolution endorsing the allotment of unexpended SEG '06 and SEG '07

WHEREAS, the Office of SBOC is being delegated the role of explaining the nature of the unexpended funds to the Office of the President of the FSM, the FSM Congress, and each of the States Governors, AND NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the unexpended SEG '06 funds be allocated to the National Department of Education to support their SEG fiscal year 2010 activities and the unexpended SEG '07 be allocated to the five aforementioned agencies equally.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the copies of this resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, The Speaker of the 16th FSM Congress, Governors of the FSM States and the Chairman of the State Boards of Education


