### **New Zealand Pacific Scholarships (Open Category): Calling for applications now!**

Do you have an inquiring mind and want to contribute to the future development of your country?

A New Zealand Pacific Scholarship will enable you to study in New Zealand in a key area that will support sustainable development of your home country.

New Zealand Pacific Scholarships are available for full-time, undergraduate or postgraduate level study at participating education institutions in New Zealand, and are funded by the New Zealand Government's international aid and development programme within the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

New Zealand Pacific Scholarship Recipients are required to return to their home country when they have completed their studies to contribute to the ongoing development of their country.

To apply you must: be citizens of and live in the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia or Palau; have completed form seven secondary school or have a Bachelors (undergraduate level) degree; be applying to start a new qualification; and satisfy the admission criteria of the New Zealand University to which you are applying, including English language criteria.

As a scholarship applicant from the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia or Palau you will need to apply directly to the New Zealand institution you wish to attend. Each institution will have its own closing date for submission of applications.
