WHEREAS a FACSSO resolution of January 2009 established full implementation of a comprehensive school improvement plan in all FSM states.

WHEREAS standards for School Improvement Plans shall be established by the Secretary of Education in accordance with Title 40.

WHEREAS these standards shall be mandatory and shall be based on the guidance contained within the document, '*School Improvement Planning: Guidance for Departments of Education, Elementary and Secondary Schools*, NDOE, 2009'.



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by FACSSO that;



- The Secretary of Education shall provide Technical Assistance to State Departments of Education upon the request of the State Director of Education.






